Tuesday at a time.*



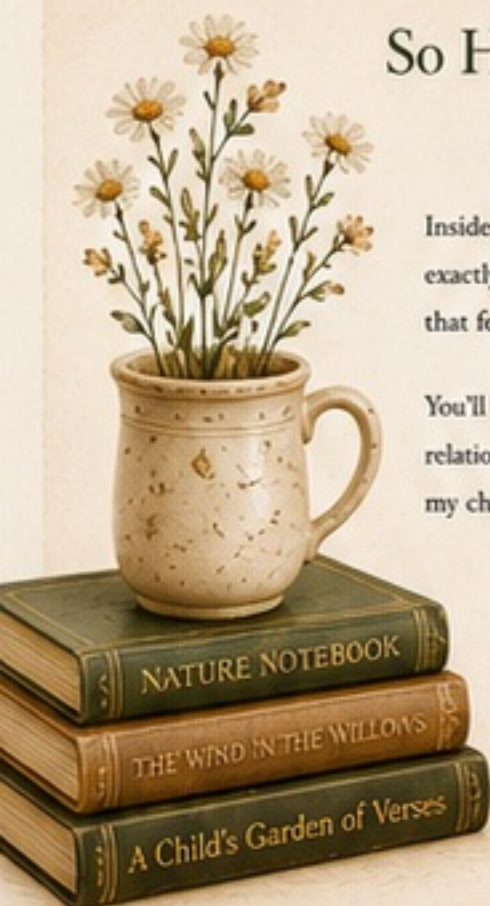
So How Does It All Fit Together?
